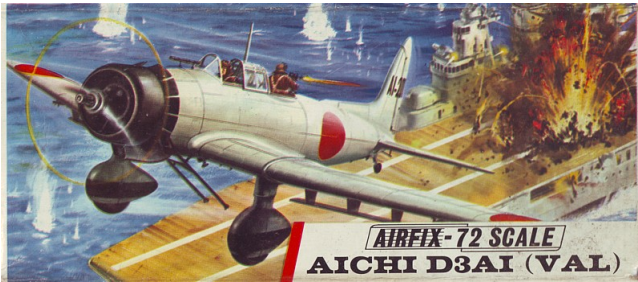

Aichi D3A1 "Val"
