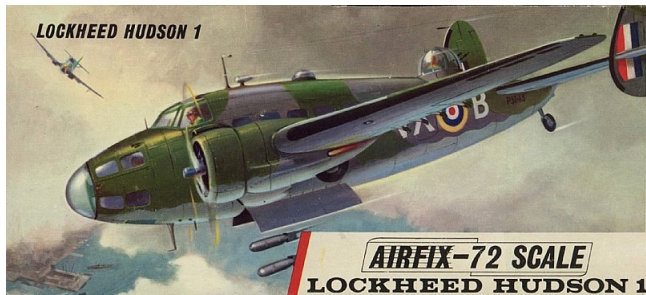

Lockheed Hudson Mk. 1
