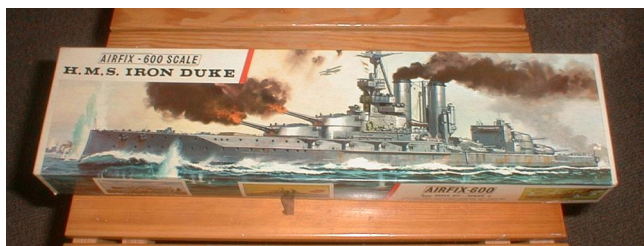

H.M.S. Iron Duke
