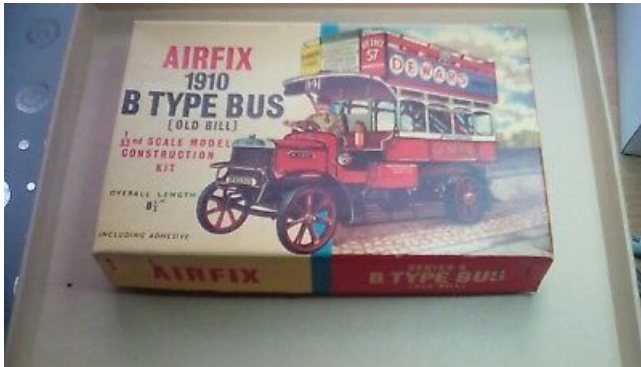

1910 'B' Type Bus

This grand old bus has been designed to the same 1/32nd scale as the Airfix range of Veteran and Modern cars, and might well be displayed with its contemporaries. A great success in its day, many hundreds were produced. In addition to use over London routes, a considerable number were shipped to Flanders during the 1914-18 war for use as troop carriers and ambulances. This famous bus is made from a 130-part kit which includes driver, conductor, and passengers.
