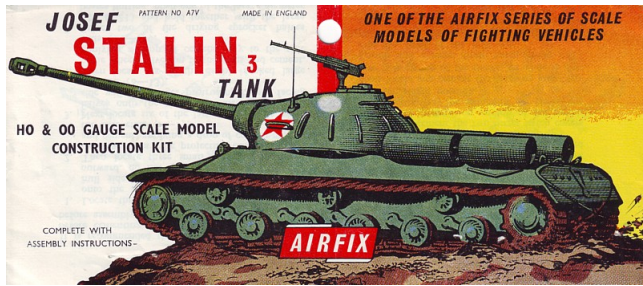

Josef Stalin 3 Tank

A development of earlier models, this fast, powerful tank first appeared in 1945. A prominent feature of the Josef Stalin 3 was the track width - each being two feet wide. This gave very light ground loading and enabled operation over soft ground and snow.
